

How to: Find the right Happy Nappy

Every baby needs a reliable swim nappy and the best way to ensure that our Happy Nappy works to the best of its ability, is to make sure that baby is wearing the right sized Happy Nappy for them. So here is a quick and easy guide to finding the right size...

Measure:



Step One: Measure around the baby's waist and tops of the thighs to get the most accurate Happy Nappy size reading. Then choose the Happy Nappy size that fits best within the measurements using the size guide below.

Finding the right size Happy Nappy for baby:

Size	Age	Weight	Waist	Leg
X Small	Newborn	3-4 kg	30-36 cm	12 cm
Small	0-4 mths	3-6 kg	36-42 cm	16 cm
Medium	3-8 mths	6-11 kg	40-46 cm	17 cm
Large	6-14 mths	10-15 kg	43-47 cm	20 cm
X Large	12-24 mths	13-18 kg	45-51 cm	21 cm
XX Large	Toddler	16 kg +	47-53 cm	23 cm

Fit:



Step Two: Once baby's size is established; roll the Happy Nappy from the waist down to the leg bands, insert baby's legs and roll the Happy Nappy back up.

Secure:



Step Three: Once worn, check to see if baby is wearing the correct Happy Nappy size by running a finger along the inside of the waist band to check that the Happy Nappy is fitted snug to the wearer. The waist and leg bands of the Happy Nappy should fit snugly and securely around the baby's waist and legs.

HINT: There should be no gaping or space in-between baby and the Happy Nappy rib bands. If gaping or sagging occurs, then we advise that baby is then fitted with a smaller Happy Nappy in order for the product to be effective. The fit of the nappy however, should not be too tight as to cause discomfort to the wearer.

Baby is now ready for swimming!
